Explore Starr's Cave Park and Starr's Cave Nature Center with Naturalist Jacqueline Goodman from Des Moines County Parks. Visit will include a short hike.

<u>Accommodations can be made</u>. The rock formations along Flint Creek in the park are not found anywhere else in the world. Starr's Cave itself is closed for the protection of the bat population. The site sits near the Mississippi River.

The sandstone bluffs offer stunning views of the Mississippi River. The Pine Mill Grist Mill is the oldest working grist mill between the Mississippi River and the Rocky Mountains.
